Canadian Music Centre:

Guidelines for the Admission of Associate Composers



1. DEADLINES

There are two submission deadlines each year:

- March 1st
- September 1st

If mailing your application, it must be postmarked on or before the deadline.

2. SUMMARY OF CRITERIA

The applicant must provide sufficient documentation that he/she is a composer who has achieved professional status in the concert music field and is recognized as such by the music community at large (local, national, international).

Basic requirements:

- Proof of Canadian citizenship or landed immigrant status.
- Completion of basic training in composition and sufficient period of establishment as a practicing composer; normally basic training will mean holding a Master's degree or the equivalent in independent study.
- The applicant must have completed five or more independently created works (i.e. works not created under pedagogical guidance).
- The applicant must have to his/her credit at least five performances and/or broadcasts by professional performers and organizations. These may include those where the composer is also a performer (note: the applicant may not list more than three of these on their application).

3. APPLICATION - DOCUMENTS AND PROCESS

Applicants are asked to submit applications to the appropriate CMC regional office for assessment (see information below to select the regional office nearest you). Your application will be assessed by your peers within the region of Canada where you live.

Applicants must provide the following documentation:

- The enclosed application form (completed and signed).
- A complete list of works (including title, year, instrumentation, and duration), and professional performances or broadcasts of those works.
- Proof of Canadian citizenship or landed immigrant status (for internal office use only).
- Copies of concert programmes.
- A curriculum vitae along with a 250 word biography.
- Three references of individuals who know the current work of the applicant and can attest to his/her professional status as a composer.

Send applications to the regional office of the applicant's residence or affiliation. (**Note**: Applicants from Alberta, Saskatchewan or Manitoba should mail their applications to the Prairie regional office. Applicants from Nova Scotia, New Brunswick, Prince Edward Island, or Newfoundland and Labrador should mail their applications to the Atlantic regional office. Applicants from Yukon Territories, Northwest Territories, and Nunavut should send their applications to the regional office of their preference).

4. APPLICATION - FEE

A non-refundable \$20.00 application fee must accompany the application. Please make cheques payable to Canadian Music Centre.

5. ASSESSMENT

Applications are assessed by the Regional Review Committee, comprised of three Associate Composers from that region selected as assessors, and a member of the CMC National Board's Composers Committee from that region acting as the non-voting chair. The members of the Regional Review Committee will meet within 30 days after the deadline.

Once the assessments are completed, recommendations are forwarded to the National Review Committee which processes them.

The CMC Board of Directors approves the final slate of new CMC Associate Composers and applicants will be notified of their acceptance in July (for March submissions) or January (for September submissions). Unsuccessful applicants may reapply.

6. CMC SERVICES

Successful applicants will be permitted to deposit works following their admission using the online submission form. Their music will be catalogued and put in the free-lending libraries of the CMC, and royalties will be paid to them on the sale and rental of their works. These and other services are described in the Associate Composer Welcome Package which will be made available to new Associate Composers.

7. ANNUAL FEE

Associate Composers must pay a yearly fee of \$125.00. This membership fee is waived for Associates who are 65 years of age and older.
